We were encouraged to reflect on which of the core character traits we needed to develop.

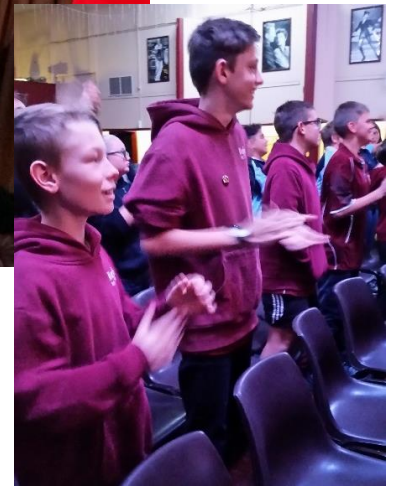
We explored how we can make a contribution to our team by:
